GROUP FOCUS QUESTIONS

Week of: January 17-23, 2021

Text: 1 Corinthians 2:16, Matthew 22:37-39, Micah 6:8,
James 1:27, Matthew 28:19-20, Acts 16:7-10, Luke 22:42

GETTING STARTED:

Share with your group briefly about a time recently when you weren't sure what God wanted you do.

DIGGING IN:

1. What does 1 Corinthians 2:16 reveal about the size of God's will and what application does that have to your life?
2. Pastor Steve distinguished between God's "general will" and His "specific will." What is the difference?
3. Mark Twain once said: "It's not the things in the Bible that I don't understand which bother me, it's the things I do understand." Is that thought relevant as you consider the subject of God's will?

DIGGING DEEPER:

1. Matthew 22:37-39 reveals the 2 biggest items on any list of God's will. What is most difficult about doing this much of God's will?
2. Share with the group something that you believe was God's will, yet you had no book, chapter and verse of Scripture to verify it.
3. Pastor Steve gave us 7 tips for discovering God's will. Which of these was most useful right now for what you are dealing with?
4. Express your opinion about Pastor Steve's statement: "The more of God's general will that you follow, the more specific His will becomes for your individual life."
5. What is your biggest "take away" from this subject?

PRAYER SUGGESTION:

Do like Jesus and express your honest desire for God to act in some way, but then end your prayer with His words: "Not my will but Yours be done."
