GROUP FOCUS QUESTIONS

Week of: January 10-16, 2021

Text: Genesis 32:22-26; Luke 9:23-25

GETTING STARTED:

Now what we're 2 weeks into the new year, which of your goals are going well so far? Which goals would you like to restart?

DIGGING IN:

- 1. The definition of Surrender: "to cease resistance to an enemy or an opponent and submit to their authority." When is a time when you think of surrendering as a virtue? Why do people resist virtuous surrendering?
- 2. Read Luke 9:23-25. How would Jesus' words have been heard in the ears of his original disciples?
- 3. What does it look like for someone to gain the world, but lose their soul?

DIGGING DEEPER:

- 1. Read Genesis 33. What stands out to you in this scene of reconciliation between Jacob & Esau?
- 2. Read 2 Corinthians 5:11-21. How do our personal reconciled relationships contribute to the ministry of Reconciliation that Jesus has called us to?

PRAYER SUGGESTION:

Pray for someone whom you need to reconcile with, & that God would open up an opportunity to take a step toward that reconciliation. Pray for our Church to be a beacon of reconciliation in our community.
