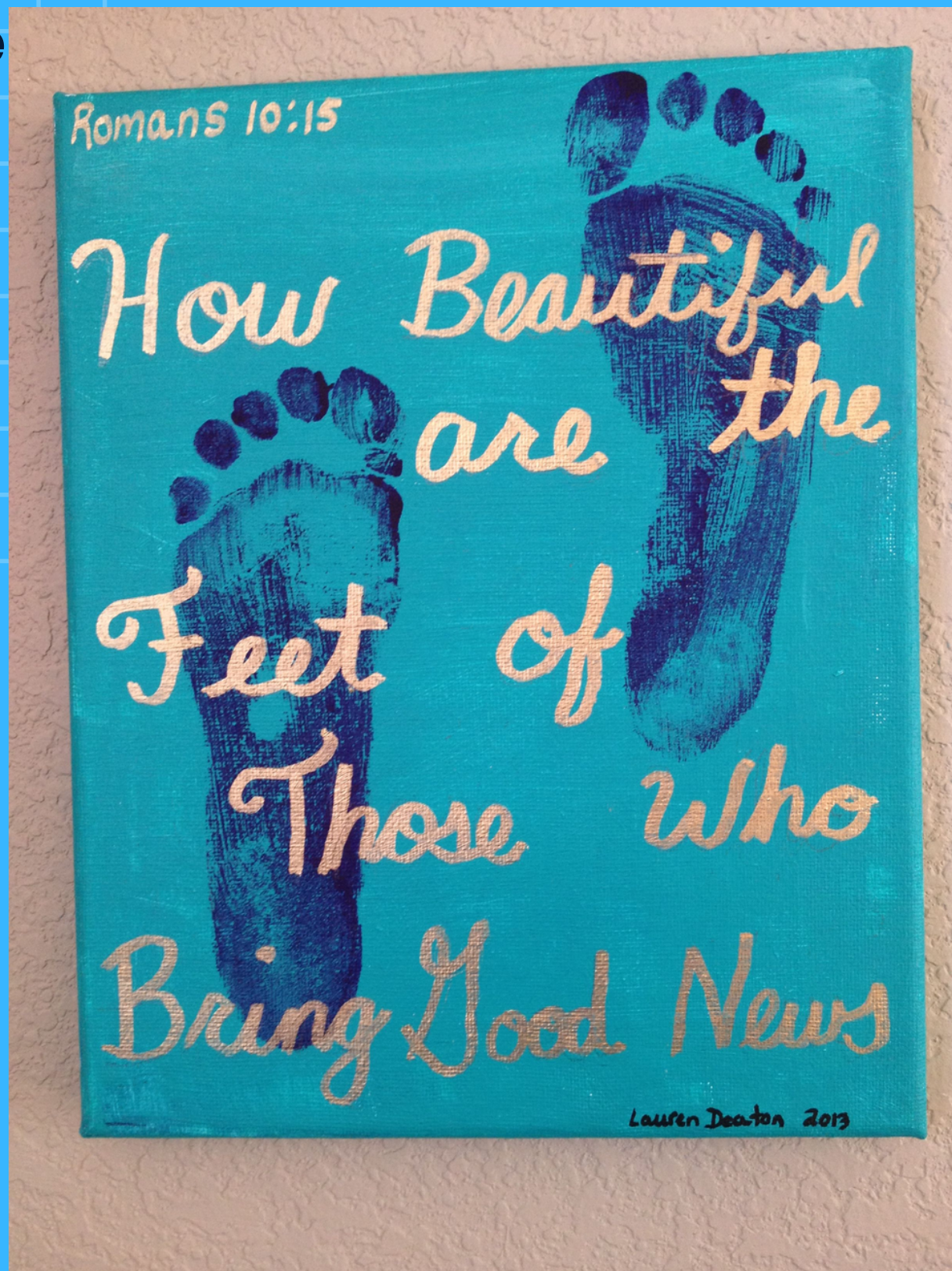
- 1. Why was the crowd so surprised to hear the disciples preaching to them in Jerusalem?**
- 2. How did the crowd respond when Peter told them that they had killed the Messiah (God's son) when they killed Jesus on the cross?**
- 3. What does "repent" mean?**
- 4. *Big Picture Question: Why does God command Christians to tell others about Jesus?***

Answers:

- 1. The crowd was so surprised because the disciples were preaching in all the different languages that the people spoke! The disciples did not know these languages, but the Holy Spirit had filled them so that they were able to speak in those languages.**
- 2. The crowd was very sorry and decided to repent.**
- 3. Repent means to turn from your sins and turn from God.**
- 4. *We tell others about Jesus so they will hear and believe the good news***

Parent Tip:
