- 4. Jesus said the bread represented his body, which will be broken on the cross for people. Jesus said the wine represented his blood, which would be poured out on the cross.
- 5. Jesus is the perfect priest because he was the perfect sacrifice for sin, and He speaks to God the Father for us today.
