Answers:


- 1. Jesus said, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny me three times."**
- 2. Yes, Jesus' words did come true. After Jesus was arrested, Peter stayed nearby to see what would happen. Three times, someone recognized Peter and asked if he was a follower of Jesus, but Peter said he did not know Jesus.**
- 3. Jesus did not fight back because he knew God's plan was for him to die on the cross to save people from sin. Even though it was hard and painful, and even though his friends abandoned him, Jesus followed his Father's plan to bring salvation to the world.**
- 4. *Jesus is the perfect priest because he was the perfect sacrifice for sin, and He speaks to God the Father for us today.***
