

MY PEOPLE SACRIFICE

Sermon Series : My People

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Gen 2:4-5; Heb 7:27; 9:26-28; 10:18

Sacrifice was directed upward but expressed outward.

1. **When we sacrifice mysteries can become miracles**
Gen 22:1-2, 9-14; Heb 11:17-19
2. **When we sacrifice our Lives God amplifies His**
Rom 12:1; Heb 13:15-16; 1 Cor 2:14-16
3. **When we sacrifice God adds His Super to our natural**
Phil 4:18-19
4. **When we sacrifice our tests become a testimony.**
Ps 50:14-15; 107:21-22
5. **When we sacrifice barriers become breakthroughs**
Heb 13:15; Ps 95:1; Jonah 2:9-10; Ps 89:15

You cannot control a lot in life but you can control the size of your worship

The word for “praise” in Heb 13:15 is used several times to translate towdah and yadah in the Old Testament.

Towdah and *Yadah* = to give thanks/confess/acknowledge, inc. extending our hands.

QUESTIONS

1. Looking at Gen 22:1-14 and Heb 11:17-19, what did Abraham know about God and his situation that would lead him to conclude that God would raise Isaac from the dead?
2. Knowing Jesus is the once-for-all sacrifice (Rom 6:10; Heb 9:28; 1Pt 3:18), how does the concept of “sacrifice” apply to us (to YOU) in the present day?
3. What does it mean to offer a sacrifice of praise (Heb 13:15)? How do the example in the context help us understand it? What are the implications for us?
4. What might God be asking you to sacrifice?
