> "For I did not speak on my own, but the Father who sent me commanded me to say all that I have spoken. I know that his command leads to eternal life. So whatever I say is just what the Father has told me to say." (Jn 12:49-50)

We walk in the authority of Jesus:

- Jesus destroyed the work of the Devil (1 Jn 3:8)
- Jesus disarmed the power of the devil (Col 2:15)
- Jesus delegated authority to his disciples (Lk 10:19; Mt 10:1)

We do not own spiritual authority we host it

- Authority = Right + Might for your Fight
- You WALK in Authority by coming UNDER Authority

Authority from Jesus comes from relationship with Jesus (Lk

4:6; Mt 16:19AMP; compare with Jn 14:10)

• Jn 4:48; Mt 11:23; Jn 14:10

We have been given authority to bless (Pv 18:21; Lk 6:28)

- One of the simplest ways we can exercise our authority is to bless others.
- You are God's poetry (Eph 2:10). Handiwork = Poiema (poy'-aymah): It's where we get our English word for poem.

- 3. Mike talked about the authority to "bless".
 - Can you think of any Scriptural blessings (or prayers) that could be used in the act of blessing? (Eg. Num 6:22-26; Eph 3:16-19).
 - b. Are there common themes?
- 4. Break into pairs so that each person has an opportunity to receive this blessing and to pray it over someone: "May the Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace."
