## QUESTIONS:

What is most important to us is the heart posture of us as His people!

## SERMON NOTES:

God uses *inanimate* things to *animate* hearts.

Church buildings can both *maximize* who you are and *minimize* who you are.

### John 2:13-16

When it was almost time for the Jewish Passover, Jesus went up to Jerusalem. In the temple courts he found people selling cattle, sheep and doves, and others sitting at tables exchanging money. So he made a whip out of cords, and drove all from the temple courts, both sheep and cattle; he scattered the coins of the money changers and overturned their tables. To those who sold doves he said, "Get these out of here! Stop turning my Father's house into a market!"

### Isaiah 56:7

these I will bring to my holy mountain and give them joy in my house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house will be called a house of prayer for all nations.

### Isaiah 56:8

The Sovereign Lord declares—he who gathers the exiles of Israel:

"I will gather still others to them besides those already gathered."

**Isaiah 66:1,2**

This is what the Lord says: “Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. Where is the house you will build for me? Where will my resting place be? Has not my hand made all these things, and so they came into being?” declares the Lord.

The temple was meant to be a place of refuge for all people.

**Dedicate:** to Set Aside for a sacred purpose

1. Prayer is how we *abandon* to Purpose.

Karl Barth said that ‘to clasp the hands in prayer is the beginning of an uprising against the disorder of the world’.

2. Prayer is how we *access* Power

3. Prayer is how we *align* with Peace
