To be wicked, evil, unfair, oppressive and missing the mark of what is right

Injustice (ἄδικία) ad-ee-kee'-ah

To violate God's standard, to show evil or wickedness

Philippians 2:1-8

Psalms 89:14

## **Retributive Justice**

Punishing is warranted as a response to a past event of injustice or wrongdoing.

## **Restorative Justice**

To seek reconciliation and repairing of relational offenses.

## **Distributive Justice**

A transfer or realignment of resources or rights from one group to another
