Discussion Questions:

Personal Reflection

- What are the contributing factors that have defined political beliefs? (upbringing, research, Buble, media, trauma, hobby, etc)
- Why might others have beliefs that counter my political beliefs? How do I view opposing beliefs (as evil, wrong, good but different?)
- Now take some time to reflect/journal on your behavior towards the topic of politics.
- How do I typically respond when sharing my belief about politics?
- How do I typically behave in opposition to my political beliefs?
- Now prayerfully ask yourself:
- Are my beliefs and behaviors towards politics showing others I am a follower of Jesus or a follower of something else?
- Is Jesus asking me to believe or behave differently towards politics in order to more closely follow Him?
