What will it take and do I have what is needed to make it?*

The resurrection of Jesus means we have full access to God!

Ephesians 2:16-18 Christ brought us together through his death on the cross. The Cross got us to embrace, and that was the end of the hostility. Christ came and preached peace to you outsiders and peace to us insiders. He treated us as equals, and so made us equals. Through him we both share the same Spirit and have equal **access** to the Father. (MSG)

Ephesians 3:12 in whom we have boldness and **access** with confidence through our faith in him. (ESV)

1. Access to Abundance over Scarcity

John 10:10 The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly. (NIV)

2. Access to New over Normal

Hebrews 10:19,20 And now we are brothers and sisters in God's family because of the blood of Jesus, and he welcomes

us to come right into the most holy sanctuary in the heavenly realm—boldly and with no hesitation. For he has dedicated a new, life-giving way for us to approach God. For just as the veil was torn in two, Jesus' body was torn open to give us free and fresh access to him! (TPT)

3. Access to Mystery over Uncertainty

Mystery is about FAITH; uncertainty is about FEAR

Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (NIV)

2. What does full access mean to you?
3. How are you making an idol out of 'normal'?
4. Read John 14:16 What does it mean to you to have been given the gift of the Comforter?
5. Have you said yes to Jesus?
6. Have you given the Holy Spirit full access to you?
