Obedience: compliance with an order, request or law; submission to another's authority

Obedience is 'I get to'; and sees God's direction as a blessing Legalism is 'I have to'; and sees God's direction as a burden

Genuine love for Christ will always manifest itself in obedience. John 4:34; John 14:15; John 14:23; 1 John 2:5; John 15:10; Luke 11:28; 1 John 5:2,3

Freedom without authority is anarchy

Galatians 5:1; 2 Corinthians 3:17; 1 Peter 2:16; James 1:25; Romans 6:16; Galatians 4:7; James 4:17

Obedience is not about Will Power... Obedience is about Willing Power

Obedience is the pipeline between hearing God's voice and holding God's blessing

The Blessings of Obedience

- Obedience positions us for increase: Hebrews 11:8
- Obedience positions us for Victory: Acts 7:39
- Obedience positions us for Encounters: Acts 5:32
- Obedience positions us for Destiny: Deuteronomy 5:33

- 1. When you hear the word obedience, what is your reaction? Read the verses about God's love manifesting obedience - how do these verses change your perspective of obedience?
- 2. Freedom can become an idol in our life. Paul says in Romans that he is free and chooses to be a bondservant to Jesus. Are you adjusting the freedom of your life to God's Word? Or are you adapting God's Word to your definition of freedom?
- 3. Logos is His spoken Word. Rhema is His everyday speaking to us. His Rhema word will always align with His Logos word. Are you living only under His Logos, or are you pressing in to His Rhema word for you? How could you invite His Rhema word?
