Luke 14:25-35

COST #1: Jesus asks for your family (Luke 14:25-26)

Jesus asks for total allegiance

COST #2: Jesus asks for your life (Luke 14:27)

Luke 9:23-26

“When you give your life to Jesus, life on your terms is over.”

Jesus asks you to count the cost (Luke 9:28-32)

COST #3: Jesus asks for all your resources (Luke 9:33)

Jesus asks us to Count the Cost;
the Spirit enables us to Pay the Price.

The cost is personalized.
