Luke 1:26-36

There is a sense of awe and wonder that:

- 1) God "tabernacles" in Mary
- 2) God chooses to bring Jesus into the world young poor women (instead of Elizabeth's priestly family)
- 3) God endures scandal through the questions about the legitimacy about Jesus' birth.
- 4) Mary humbly submits to God
- 5) Joseph commits to Mary (and Jesus)
- 6) The baby's reaction in Elizabeth's womb
- 7) Mary's song of praise

We magnify the sense of awe & wonder by:

- expressing Joy (v46)
- embracing humility (v47-48)
- praising God and his works (v50-54)
- resting in his promises (v55)
