ONTOLOGI


Dealing with the nature of "being"

Celebrate it (PTZIDE)

Manage it (TZELIGTON)

Or hide it (SHAME)



Shame is not "I have done something wrong."

Shame is "I am something wrong."

Jesus wants to cancel those lies.

Jesus doesn't just want to heal your *pain*,

He wants to heal your *person*.

TRANSFORMING = CONFOTZMING = FORMING

A TRANSFORMED LIFE MOVES US FROM:

Victim to Victor Restless to Resting Worthless to Worth-full Pleasing people to Releasing People Insecurity to Security Absence to Access Poverty to Provision Intimidated to Intimidating Worry to Worship Prevented to Presence Proving to Approved Fear to Freedom

BEINGTA DISCIPLE IS WHEN WE EXPETZIENCE AND EXPIZESS THE Essence of Jesus.

REVEAL (APOCALYPTIC)

From Unseen / Unknown to Seen / Knowing

EPHESIANS 5:25-27

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.

RADIANT GLOTZIOUS (ENDOXOS)

Honor, value, majesty, perfection

Living the vision of Jesus means *partnering* with the *preparation* of Jesus.

Seasons of *preparation* are often seasons of *purifying*.

RADIANT REVEAUNG

A fresh experience of spiritual outpouring by the Holy Spirit among Jesus followers which manifests in a renewed hunger and passion for God's presence and His Word, a shaking out of spiritual complacency, a desire for holy Living, a bold ambition to reach the lost, a deeper love for one another, an intensity in prayer and worship, a breakout of signs and wonders, an expression of generosity and compassion.


May the triumph of the Lamb replace the tribalism of our flesh.

DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS



DISCIPLESHIP COMMUNITIES

A Discipleship Community is a group of 6-12 people or couples who meet in homes regularly.

DISCIPLESHIP COHORTS

A Discipleship Cohort is a group of 3-6 men or women who will commit to meeting regularly.
