Diluted: to reduce the strength or make something weaker by mixing in something else

A diluted faith becomes a disillusioned faith

To the angel of the church in Thyatira write:

...These are the words of the Son of God, whose eyes are like blazing fire and whose feet are like burnished bronze.

Revelation 2:18

bronze feet represent Jesus justice and correction, flaming red eyes represent purity

Mr. Rogers Jesus Biggest Loser Jesus

Jesus meets us where we are, but he also leads us to where we need to be

I know your deeds, your love and faith, your service and perseverance, and that you are now doing more than you did at first.

Nevertheless, I have this against you: You tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophet. By her teaching she misleads my servants into sexual immorality and the eating of food sacrificed to idols. Revelation 2:19-20 The world claims tolerance as a blessing and Jesus claims tolerance as a curse **Tolerate:** To let go or to allow with permission **Intolerance:** To not permit or accept

Step 1: You have to start by replacing the label of the one who poisons with (Victim) Step 2: You have to replace the label of the one who protects with (Villain) Step 3: Redefine the moral compass

Holiness becomes Hate Tolerance becomes Love

We must not flinch at proclaiming the absolutes of Scripture

Love people and speak truth

Don't confuse intolerance with indifference Don't use Holy Intolerance to become a Holy Introvert Don't leverage intolerance as a right to interrogate

How to be a church who doesn't tolerate sin

Unchecked sin leads to unhealthy outcomes Tolerance to sin leads to greater toxicity of sin Passivity to sin leads to passageways of the enemy

3 Jezebel teachings. 1 Kings 18 and 21

- 1. **My truth over God's truth** (Relativism) v18:4
- 2. **My gain over Christ's gain** (Egoism) v21:4, 7, 15
- My pleasure over God's pleasing (Hedonism) v21:25-26. Hedonism: belief that pleasure is the highest good

Not everyone who is for you is good for you

Now I say to the rest of you in Thyatira, to you who do not hold to her teaching and have not learned Satan's so-called deep secrets, 'I will not impose any other burden on you, except to hold on to what you have until I come.'

To the one who is **victorious** and does my will to the end, I will **give authority over the nations**.....that one 'will rule them with an iron scepter and will dash them to pieces like pottery'—just as I have received authority from my Father. I will also **give that one the morning star**. Revelation 2:24-28

The seduction to an idol creates a reduction of faith

QUESTIONS:

1-Is there an area of your faith that has become diluted by mixing in other things?

2-Are you more drawn to the Mr. Rogers Jesus who loves and accepts all? Or to the Biggest Loser/Fitness Coach Jesus who draws a line and calls you to a place of holiness? What temptations could each lead to if taken too far? If you find yourself feeling defensive about a Jesus who calls us into holiness, why do you think that is? How do you find that balance of loving people and pursuing holiness?

3-How have you experienced the villainizing of another? Or the victimizing? Give an example of how you have seen yourself, someone else, or culture redefine a moral compass. 4-How can we, as a small group/ as a church, be accountable to one another in sin areas? Unchecked sin? Tolerance to sin? Passiviity to sin?

5-Which of the 3 Jezebel teachings are you most drawn into? My truth over God's truth My gain over Christ's gain My pleasure over God's pleasing Read these scriptures about dying to self. *Luke 9:18-27, Galatians 2:17-21, Colossians 3:1-11, 1 Peter 4:1-11, 2 Corinthians 5:16-21* How do they speak to these ideas of relativism, egoism, and hedonism?

Pray: Show us the places where we are agreeing with a jezebel spirit. Thank you that you show up with the eyes of fire and purity. Illuminate those areas we need to come clean about. We give you permission Holy Spirit to shine a spotlight on the areas of life where we've drifted.
