Our destiny is to be conformed to the image of Jesus (Rom 8:29a)

Q: Are we seeking to be conformable or comfortable?

Satan sends a lie to kill your why.

- Lie of distraction
- Lie of identity
- Lie of trust
- Lie of rejection
- Lie of discouragement

The Holy Spirit conforms us to the image of Jesus (2 Cor 3:8)

Q: What and who does the Holy Spirit use to conform us to Christ?

- What: is where I partner with God in my transformation (Jas 1:2-4)
- Who: is where I partner with others in my transformation (eg. Prov 27:17; Heb 10:24-25)

"A place to be known, not as you are but as you are seen from Heavens perspective."

Our relational strategy:

Park > Coffee Shop > Living Room.
