
With many similar parables Jesus spoke the word to them, as much as they could understand. He did not say anything to them without using a parable. But when he was alone with his own disciples, he explained everything.































A BRILLIANT CHURCH GATHERS AROUND PURPOSE AND PRESENCE MORE THAN POLITICS AND PREFERENCE.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS PART ONE What lessons of the way of Jesus are difficult for you to HEAR? Read Mark 4:9-11. What kinds of things do you find worthy of celebrating? What would it look like to celebrate the way of Jesus? Practicing power requires us aligning with God's agenda rather than expecting God to join ours. His kingdom cannot be stopped! Are you seeing powerful change as a result of aligning with His plans, or are you doing more 'talking'? Are you being intentional about finding and following gospel solutions, or do you get pulled into worldly solutions? (See chart)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS PART TWO Read the quote by A.W. Tozer. In what ways do you see the world as a playground? How would your life look differently if you saw the world as a battleground? How have you seen the church transcend both passivity and violence by finding a third way? Read Mark 4:15-20. We may be receiving pieces of God's Word in different ways. Is there anything in God's word that is falling on a heart in you? A fickle heart? A halfway heart? A hungry heart? Who can you carry the love and truth of Jesus to this week?
