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Storms come through obedience and through consequence

Sometimes He calms the storm, other times He invites you to walk on them.

Hopelessness is a decision based on a distortion.

Ps 42:5 Heb 6:17-19

In order to NAVIGATE at some point you have to ACTIVATE

Courage is spelled R-I-S-K

Peter didn't want the "walking on water," he wanted JESUS! He wasn't looking to have a miracle experience, He simple wanted to come to Him.

When our eyes fail us we need to depend on our hearing... Hearing from the Lord can open our eyes to the Lord. Hunger and humility create an atmosphere of supernatural.

When curiosity is greater than control it will often lead to communion.
