Celebrate:

to make widely known, to praise, to make famous, to honor

From martus ("testify") we get the English word "martyr,"

The Hebrew word for "testimony" is *edut*, which means "witness" or "record." It contains the idea "duplicate" or "repeat".

 $\label{eq:constraint} It\ represented-re-presented-His\ presence\ among\ them.$

- 1. Testimonies recycle the past (1 Cor 2:2-5) Your mess is your message; Your test is your testimony; Your story gives God glory
- 2. Testimonies transform destinies (John 4:39-42)
- 3. Testimonies lead to triumph (Rom 12:10-11)
- **4. Testimonies unlock breakthroughs (**John 15:26; 6:63) Acts 1:8; Heb 2:3-4; Rev 19:10

Testimony is When God turns information into transformation.

Prophecy is a testimony of Jesus that hasn't happened yet.

QUESTIONS

- 1. What does it mean to "testify"? Why is this important? (Consider 2 Cor 4:7-18 & 12:6-10)
- 2. What has God done in your life (recently)? What can you do to celebrate that (individually or as a Group)?
- Take time (perhaps over a few weeks) to share your "testimony"-NOT the story of how <u>you</u> became a Christian, but the story of <u>God's work</u> in transforming you. Consider these questions:
 - What challenges have you faced? How has God helped you overcome them?
 - What areas of broken has God healed (or is he healing)?
 - What transformation has God worked in you? What events/ experiences facilitated the transformation?

Remember: Your mess is your message; Your test is your testimony.
