The Cultural shift and motivation for this series –
We need to make a Spiritual shift –
If you were to go to Jerusalem today –
love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. ⁶ And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. ⁷ You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸ You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹ You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.
Application: There are components to <u>" "</u> Spiritual Formation that are baseline in order to pass on the faith from Gen-to-Gen.
1 – Belief in the GOD (6:4).
2 – Love GOD with your (6:5).
3 – Have these words of GOD on heart (6:6).
4 – Impress them on your in the everyday stuff of life (6:7-9).

Vision Statement: Knowing God and making Him Known.

- 2. What does it mean to love GOD with your heart (v. 6)?
- 3. What are ways you can "impress" these on your children? (v. 7, NIV)
- 4. How can you partner with the church to be more well rounded concerning all the above?
