## Review:

- GOD's wrath is revealed against you by natural consequences (1:18)
- GOD's wrath remains on you in order to lead you to repentance (2:4)
- Stubborn refusal to repent stores up wrath for Judgment Day (2:5)
- Everyone will be judged by GOD's Law & your conscience (2:16)
- No one is exempt from GOD's wrath (3:1-20, 23)

"But I'm a good person. I've lived a decent life. That's not fair."
Will not work!

## **Application Questions**

## Read Romans 3:21-31 and then walk through verse-by-verse

- 1) In 3:21 what is the "Law & Prophets"?
- 2) In 3:22 the words "through <u>faith in</u> Jesus" could be translated "through <u>the faithfulness of</u> Jesus" → how does this phrasing change the meaning? Dos it matter? Why or why not?
- 3) In 3:23 compare this verse to 5:12 → is this saying that every individual has sinned or Adam sinned and therefore we all fall short?
- 4) This is a four-part question:
  - a. In 3:24 define "justification"
  - b. In 3:24 define "redemption"
  - c. In 3:25 define "atonement"
  - How are "Justification, redemption, and atonement" achieved?
- 5) How did GOD demonstrate His righteousness (3:26) by making salvation attainable by faith in Jesus Christ? [Note: you need to understand 3:21-25 in order to answer this question]
- 6) Based on your understanding of the above, how does faith in Christ help you live a righteous life w/o boasting? (summary of vv. 27-31)
- 7) What difference does any of this make in your life? Why does understanding this matter? [Lets get down to brass tacks]
