



Q2: Just as a team cannot win unless it has the same definition of winning, so also a church cannot make disciples unless it can define a disciple: How would you define a "disciple" of Jesus?

**Read:** Luke 5:1-11 and Matthew 4:19 – according to these passages, how does Jesus define a disciple?

Q3: Consider your schedule, time, priorities, and how you spend money – what does this say about your commitment to following Jesus?

**Read:** Mark 12:30 – according to the Great Commandment *the most* important thing in life is to love GOD with your whole being:

- What HEAD-level changes take place when you first believe?
- What HEART-level changes take place when you realize what it means to truly follow Jesus as His disciple?
- What HANDs-level changes demonstrate you are following Jesus?

**Q4:** How are you doing in terms of loving GOD with your HEAD, HEART, & HANDs? What hinders you from *fully following Jesus*?

Take Away: If you desire to fully follow Jesus, plan time this week to pray and ask GOD to help evaluate your priorities by answering: What is? What ought to be? What needs to stay? What needs to go? What needs to change? From the answers you write down make an action plan to share with your spouse, mentor, or friend in your group.

## Read Luke 5:1-11

Luke 5:1 On one occasion, while the crowd was pressing in on him to hear the word of God, he was standing by the lake of Gennesaret, <sup>2</sup> and he saw two boats by the lake, but the fishermen had gone out of them and were washing their nets. <sup>3</sup> Getting into one of the boats, which was Simon's, he asked him to put out a little from the land. And he sat down and taught the people from the boat. <sup>4</sup> And when he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch."

<sup>5</sup> And Simon answered, "Master, we toiled all night and took nothing! But at your word I will let down the nets."

<sup>6</sup> And when they had done this, they enclosed a large number of fish, and their nets were breaking. <sup>7</sup> They signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. <sup>8</sup> But when Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord." <sup>9</sup> For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish that they had taken, <sup>10</sup> and so also were James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." <sup>11</sup> And when they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed him.
