Q3: Why is step 4 important?

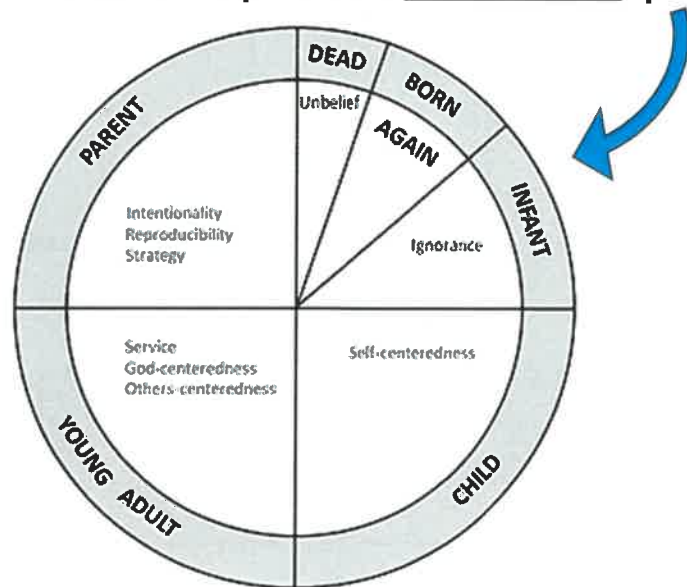
Takw Away: If you have never shared Christ, **develop a testimony** based on steps 1-3 above. Related to step 4, the rest of this bulletin insert has a basic framework of the Gospel of Jesus and Scripture references. **Read and know** where to find these scriptures and think through your testimony so that if you have a chance to share with someone you know, you will feel confident prepared. **Why SHARE?** It says in **Acts 4:12** – *“Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.”*
