2. Which counterfeits have you personally struggled with or fallen prey to?
3. What happens to these counterfeits when you apply one or more of the "litmus tests" below?

Litmus Tests:

- 1—Is it bringing me closer to God... or pushing me farther away?
- 2—Is it bringing me closer to other Christians... or farther away?
- 3—Is it God's wisdom? Or human "wisdom"? Is it consistent with Scripture?
- 4—Is it about religion... or a relationship with Jesus?

The Parables of Jesus

God Creates, Satan Counterfeits

Today's Parable: The Parable of the Weeds (Wheat & the Tares)

Matthew 9:24 **Jesus told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. ²⁵ But while everyone was sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away. ²⁶ When the wheat sprouted and formed heads, then the weeds also appeared.**

²⁷ **"The owner's servants came to him and said, 'Sir, didn't you sow good seed in your field? Where then did the weeds come from?'**

²⁸ **"An enemy did this,' he replied.**

"The servants asked him, 'Do you want us to go and pull them up?'

²⁹ **"No,' he answered, 'because while you are pulling the weeds, you may uproot the wheat with them. ³⁰ Let both grow together until the harvest. At that time I will tell the harvesters: First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat and bring it into my barn.'"**

What is Jesus Teaching Us in this Parable?

1. There is encouragement for believers and a warning to unbelievers about Judgement Day

2. **There is a warning about counterfeits and lies planted by the enemy to sabotage God's handiwork**
