Sin is our root problem: The lesson of Gen 3:1-21

- 1. We are created in God's image and likeness for Shalom naked and not ashamed
- 2. Sin entered the world with a false promise Your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God
- 3. It didn't turn out as expected the eyes of both were opened, and they knew that they were naked
- 4. Their harmonious relationship with God was broken and replaced with a new one *curses and coverings*.
