We're beyond grateful that **3,025 people** attended our Christmas Eve services and got to hear about the birth of Jesus Christ.



MLK SUMMIT

The 2023 MLK Summit was a night full of sincere conversations as we encouraged and challenged each other around the issues of unity and justice. We leaned into the way Jesus loved us, even though we were different from him, and discussed how we as a church could continue to grow to be a place where we love well, especially those who do not look like us. Just under 200 kids, students, and *adults* attended, listened to, and discussed Dr. King's famous "I Have a Dream" speech.



MIDDLE SCHOOL SKY ZONE NIGHT

The Middle School Sky Zone Night was a great event for middle schoolers to hang out with one another and invite friends to do the same. We had 127 students register for Sky Zone, and 42 students indicated they wanted to take next steps with Jesus!

HIGH SCHOOL DODGEBALL NIGHT

We had such a great turnout for High School Dodgeball Night. 92 students attended the event, and 25 students stated they would like to talk more about life with Jesus. Our high school team has personally followed up with every student who expressed interest and has already started meeting with them to talk about Jesus.

KIDS GLOW NIGHT

Our Kids Ministry welcomed 223 kids at Glow Night, and 68 kids who were brand new to CCC came with their friends. We had one family come to church the next morning after their kids were at Glow Night. And another new family was looking for a church, checked out CCC, and made it their church home!

Revolution Church, pastored by John Twymon, launched on Easter Sunday! We praise God for his faithfulness.



CLEARVIEW COMMUNITY CHURCH (EUCLID)

We praise God that ClearView Community Church, pastored by Lentrail Abston, will be launching this September! Pastor Lentrail currently hosts Life Group, where young people meet weekly at a local library, and he meets with the students' parents. As a result of this, two students came to Christ in discipleship!

Pastor Lentrail and his launch team currently fellowship twice a month in his home. A possible ongoing meeting place in Euclid has been found, and meetings with the mayor have also produced possible places for ClearView Community Church to serve. Jeremy King is the planting pastor of Story Church in Mayfield Heights. The greater Mayfield area would not have this gospel-centered church committed to sharing the story of Jesus with them if it were not for the generous support and prayers of the members of Christ Community Chapel. Story Church would like to thank you for trusting the Lord in this endeavor.

Story Church is in their third year of public worship, and since their launch in October of 2020, it is continuing to grow month after month as men and women, young and old, come and hear the good news of Jesus, who freely offers us the rest our souls long for.

WINGFOOT CHURCH (GOODYEAR HEIGHTS)

Pastored by Jon Ashley, Wingfoot Church would like to thank you for your support and prayers since their launch in October of 2020. Since our last gathering in the fall, Wingfoot Church has baptized two people, added 12 members to their church family, dedicated nine babies, hosted around 100 people for Thanksgiving, and expanded the kids' ministry on Sundays because the church has so many kids and young families.

Additionally, Wingfoot Church just won a grant from the city of Akron to create a new after-school youth mentoring program as part of a city-wide initiative to end youth violence. Pastor Jon Ashley would like to thank you for your prayers and support as they continue to renew hope in the Heights in Jesus' name!





EVERYWHERE EVERYWHERE

CCC aims to give \$30 million to global missions over the next 30 years. We desire to contribute to a Jesus-centered witness everywhere around the world. So far, we have given over \$1.2 million toward this goal. Here are some updates and things to look forward to as we continue to strive toward this goal.

NEW GLOBAL OUTREACH INITIATIVE WITH INDIA GOSPEL LEAGUE

This year, we will focus on a new region in India to continue a saturation churchplanting movement with our current partner, India Gospel League. Within Maharashtra, a new region has been identified where a concentrated effort will take place for five years to plant churches. The expected outcome is 440 new churches by the end of the five-year period. In addition, 120 new church planters will be equipped for ongoing church planting. Lay workers, including women, men, youth and children, will be disciples, and rural development initiatives will allow for sustainable ministry for the future.





GLOBAL OUTREACH NEW PARTNERS

The global team is continually searching for partners who share our vision for starting churches in the least-reached regions of the world. We are excited to extend outreach to areas where CCC has never previously worked. This year, new initiatives have started in Ethiopia. We have committed to two new partners who minister in vital ways in church planting in an unreached region.

The Timothy Initiative trains and equips church planters who otherwise would not have the means to receive theological training.

Firm Foundations in Christ Ministry is a discipleship ministry that comes alongside new believers providing training and resources to help them thrive in a joyful relationship with God through Jesus Christ.



BHUTANESE-NEPALESE CHURCHES OF AMERICA (BNCA) CONFERENCE // JUN. 28 - JUL. 1

CCC is hosting the 10th Annual BNCA Conference Jun. 28 through Jul. 1. This conference is for the Bhutanese Nepalese Churches of America. Akron has become a significant hub for Nepalese refugees, and there are currently over 20,000 residing here. Within that population, there are 11 Christian churches serving the refugee community. Our goal is to help strengthen Nepalese churches by opening our building for their conference. As this is a national conference, it will allow Nepalese pastors from Akron to encourage other pastors from around the country. We expect 1,500 people in attendance at the conference.

TOGO MISSIONS TRIP // JUL. 6-16

For this vision trip, participants will travel to the West African nation of Togo, where you will meet workers taking the gospel to unreached areas of the country. Experience firsthand how the gospel transforms a completely unreached region. This trip will focus on building relationships through sharing testimonies, prayer, encouragement, and fellowship. The trip will culminate with a training conference to equip pastors and Christian workers. Some team members will teach or share a devotion, while others will pray or serve those attending the training conference.

HAITI MISSIONS TRIP // OCT. 25-31

Participants will travel to Haiti and work with our partner, Community Lifecenters of Haiti. They will work alongside Haitians, helping the newly planted church with several projects on their recently acquired property. On this trip, you will also participate in several community outreach projects, such as bringing fresh drinking water to isolated people who have none or sharing the gospel during a community sporting event. Participants should expect to work during the week but will also enjoy worship and an anniversary celebration for the church on the weekend. We need between 10 and 15 people to join this team to have a large enough work team.


