




2023 FINANCIAL SUMMARY



BIRDSONG UPDATE

Birdsong is soaring in the city of Hudson! The community is engaging with it in many ways. The Birdsong page on the Door 2 website has been viewed from 3,000 unique devices. 98% of these visits have been from people who had not previously been a contact of Door 2. Door 2 artists were featured in two gallery shows connected to Birdsong at Western Reserve Academy and Peg's Foundation.
