REIMAGINE CLASS:

So far, we have had over **1,000 people** take the Reimagine Class.

SERVE (+01):

Currently, we have **603 people** plugged in and serving with the various ministries at CCC!

CIRCLES (+02):

We have **865 people** who are a part of a Circle. **500** of those people have joined a Circle in the past year!

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (+03):

We have heard so many encouraging stories about members of our congregation getting involved in their communities! Here are a few examples:

- Members of several Circles have partnered with Navigators at Kent State to serve **353 meals** to **137 international students**.
- We have members who have helped provide **325 meals** per week to children facing food insecurity in the greater Akron area.
- One Circle cuts down trees in their community for free. So far, they're at **55 trees** and counting!
- There are many more examples of members coaching, tutoring, and serving in their communities!

Our Member Engagement team exists to walk the path of discipleship with each member at their own pace and in a way that makes sense for them. Whether your next step is committing to membership at CCC, finding a place to serve, joining a Circle, or impacting your community for Jesus, the Member Engagement team is ready and willing to help you take that step!

Our outdoor services are an accessible way for those who don't usually attend church to try it in a relaxed and fun environment! This summer, we estimate that over **5,650 people** attended our four outdoor services.

KIDS CAMP

Kids Camp is an excellent opportunity for our congregation to invite families who don't have a church home or who maybe don't know Jesus at all. This year, we had **865 kids** register, and **108 kids** decided to follow Jesus after being presented with the truth of the gospel!

MIDDLE SCHOOL GAMES

Middle School Games 2022 was a crazy week of fun! We had **133 students** register, **20** of whom had never attended anything at CCC before. Our student team had at least **14** follow-up conversations with students who indicated they wanted to learn more about starting a relationship with Jesus.

WOMEN'S MINISTRY

Our Women's Ministry is constantly finding new ways to connect with women in the community. One highlight from this summer was their Craft & Conversation nights, where **115** unique women attended across three events. They also hosted a Parents' Brunch at Kids Camp, where over **90 women** attended and heard the message of the gospel!

MEN'S MINISTRY

Our Men's Ministry at CCC exists to help men find community and grow in their faith. They recently hosted Cruisin' the Chapel in partnership with Don Sitts Auto Group. Over **1,000 people** attended, and **\$20,000** was raised for Mobility Worldwide.

DOOR 2 ART STUDIO

Our Door 2 Art Studio has a unique opportunity to connect with people who would perhaps never step foot into a church. From April to July, this team had almost **160 individual spiritual conversations** with artists and members of the community. They also saw **110 people** take a next step at CCC!

We believe that local, neighborhood-based churches are the most effective way to impact a community in the name of Jesus. That is why we plan to plant 60 gospel-preaching churches throughout Northeast Ohio in the next 30 years. We hope you are encouraged by the updates on the churches that have already launched and join us in prayerfully looking ahead at our next two church plants!

WINGFOOT CHURCH (*GOODYEAR HEIGHTS*)

Pastored by Jon Ashley, Wingfoot Church has recently spearheaded initiatives to bless their neighborhood, allowing them to have over 30 gospel conversations with community members as a result. They also launched a third house church community, meaning they now have over 45 people being disciplined this way! Finally, their Kids Ministry is busting at the seams, and they are expanding to offer programming for kids up to age 12.

Pastor Jon has asked that we pray for their congregation to continue deepening connections with their neighbors. Also, pray that they would be peacemakers. The city of Akron is hurting. Pray that the people of Wingfoot would enter into difficult conversations, pray and lament together, and demonstrate the reconciling power of Jesus.



STORY CHURCH (MAYFIELD HEIGHTS)

Story Church, pastored by Jeremy King, is celebrating a wonderful summer of fellowship, outreach, and growth. They continue to find ways to impact their neighborhood and have added five households (eight adults and five children) to their congregation this summer.

Pastor Jeremy has asked that we pray for their fall season of ministry. They have three events planned each month for building new relationships with neighbors, growing in fellowship as a church, and deepening their faith through steps of leadership. Please pray that they would be both faithful and fruitful for their growing church.



SILVER CREEK CHURCH (AURORA)

Reaching full independence in January 2022, Silver Creek Church is pastored by Todd Iannetta. They desire to see the congregation develop a heart for reaching their community for Christ. This year, they are encouraging all of their community groups to host an outreach event in their neighborhoods.

Pastor Todd has asked that we pray for their congregation to be bold and to share the gospel this year with those who are not yet Christians.



THE GROVE (BEACHWOOD)

The Grove launched in the Beachwood area in April 2022 and is pastored by Ray Byrne. They have been blessed by a core group of people committed to worshipping and serving each week.

Pastor Ray has asked that we pray for positive connections and opportunities in their local community so they can bear fruit for the Kingdom.




STEVE HYATT // ORCHARD NEO DIRECTOR

Anthony is a true Northeast Ohioan living in the Shalersville-Mantua area for almost his entire life. He only resided outside of Northeast Ohio when he attended Wheaton College in Illinois. While there, Anthony graduated Summa Cum Laude with a bachelor's degree in Biblical and Theological Studies and a minor in Philosophy. When he is not working, Anthony is either reading, writing, or spending time with friends and loved ones – typically over a nice Italian meal! He is deeply passionate about seeing people find peace and truth in Christ and loves to help make that happen in any way he can.

LENTRAIL ABSTON // CHURCH PLANTING RESIDENT



Jesus can turn prisoners into pastors! He did so with Lentrail Abston, who grew up in East Cleveland, Ohio, where most young men find themselves either in the grave or prison. Without a father or positive role models, Lentrail missed death but struck prison. While in prison, Jesus saved him and changed his future forever.

Lentrail is married to Ingrid, and they have three children, Amir (4), Amaia (3), and Avi (1). The Abstons will be planting in Euclid, Ohio. Euclid is east of Cleveland and has a population of about 47,000 people. The city is diverse with many single-parent homes, working middle class, and seniors who have called the city home for their entire lives. He hopes to apply the gospel in such a way that connects people to what matters most in life.

JOHN TWYMON // CHURCH PLANTING RESIDENT



John Twymon is a native of the Lee-Harvard area of Cleveland, Ohio. He is happily married to his wife, Frankie. After years of Christian leadership and instructing various courses, seminars, and conferences, John accepted his calling from God to preach the word in December 2013.

After serving for six years as assistant pastor under his father, Dr. Johnny F. Twymon, he was led by God to plant a church. Revolution Church will be launching Easter of 2023, located in a southeast suburban area of Cleveland.

John was educated at the University of Akron and Moody Bible Institute. He is pursuing his Master of Theology (ThM) at Dallas Theological Seminary. He has instructed courses for the North American School of Theology, preached and taught the gospel, and completed missionary work in the U.S., Canada, Africa, and the Virgin Islands.

In this next season, as our Orchard team prepares to launch two new churches, our Church Planting Residents will walk through four distinct phases. We have a team that supports our Residents through these phases due to the continued generosity of our congregation!

PHASE 1 // PREPARATION

- We work with our planters to identify a local community where they can share the gospel in meaningful, specific ways.

PHASE 2 // MISSIONARY

- During phase two, the planters will work to understand their target community. They do this by making observations with openness and acceptance.

PHASE 3 // CHURCH PLANTER

- Based on their observations, the planters will craft their church vision to address the specific needs of their community. They will begin to disciple local people and construct the ministries of their church leading up to launch.

PHASE 4 // PASTOR

- Post-launch, our Orchard NEO team will continue to walk alongside the church plant as it begins its transition to independence. The pastors will raise up elders and establish the rhythms of everyday pastoring, discipleship, and weekly worship so their church can impact their community in the name of Jesus.

We support several organizations in Slavic countries, including Slavic Missionary Services and the Slavic Gospel Association. Thanks to your generosity, our total giving to these organizations recently passed **\$100,000**. These funds contributed toward relief for the crisis in Ukraine, specifically supporting refugees seeking to flee the country.

HAITI // WORK TRIP JANUARY 21-28*

Travel to the country of Haiti and work with our partner, Community Life Centers of Haiti. Participants will work side by side with Haitians, helping a newly planted church with several projects on their recently acquired property. You will also participate in community outreach projects such as bringing fresh drinking water to isolated people who have none or sharing the gospel during a community sporting event.

TOGO // VISION TRIP JULY 6-16*

Participants will travel to the West African nation of Togo where they will meet workers taking the gospel to unreached areas of the country. Experience firsthand how the gospel transforms an entirely unreached region. This trip will build relationships through sharing testimonies, prayer, encouragement, and fellowship and will culminate with a training conference to equip pastors and Christian workers.



WEDNESDAY NIGHT KIDS PROGRAMMING // JAN. 18


