& 22:3

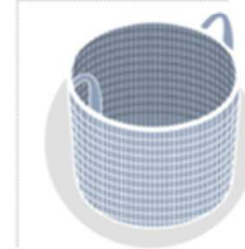


As persecutor of the Church, Paul approves of Stephen's stoning.

Paul and Barnabas bring aid to Jerusalem.

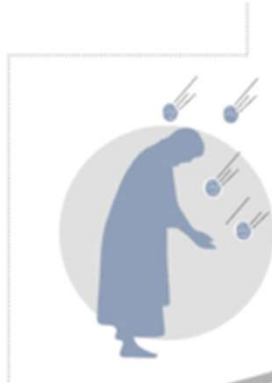
At Antioch in Pisidia, Paul preaches in the synagogue.

Paul and Barnabas return to Antioch.

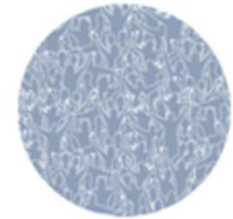
Returning to Antioch, Paul confronts Peter.

Paul to leave.



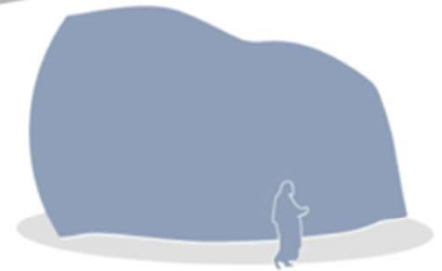

In Troas, a young man named Eutychus dies while Paul is speaking. Paul raises him from the dead.



Paul travels to Macedonia where he writes 2 Corinthians.



Paul returns to Jerusalem for Pentecost.



Paul is arrested in Jerusalem.



Paul addresses the crowd in Jerusalem.



Paul speaks before the Sanhedrin.



Paul appeals to be brought before Caesar.



King Agrippa asks to hear Paul speak.



Paul's Roman citizenship saves him from being beaten.



The Jews plot to kill Paul.

Paul speaks before Felix in Caesarea.



Paul is shipwrecked on Malta.



Paul sails for Rome.



Paul arrives in Rome and lives there under house arrest.

While imprisoned, Paul writes Philippians, Colossians, Ephesians, and Philemon.



Paul is released from Roman imprisonment and travels more.

Paul may have written 1 and 2 Timothy and Titus at this time.



Paul returns to Rome. He is imprisoned and martyred.



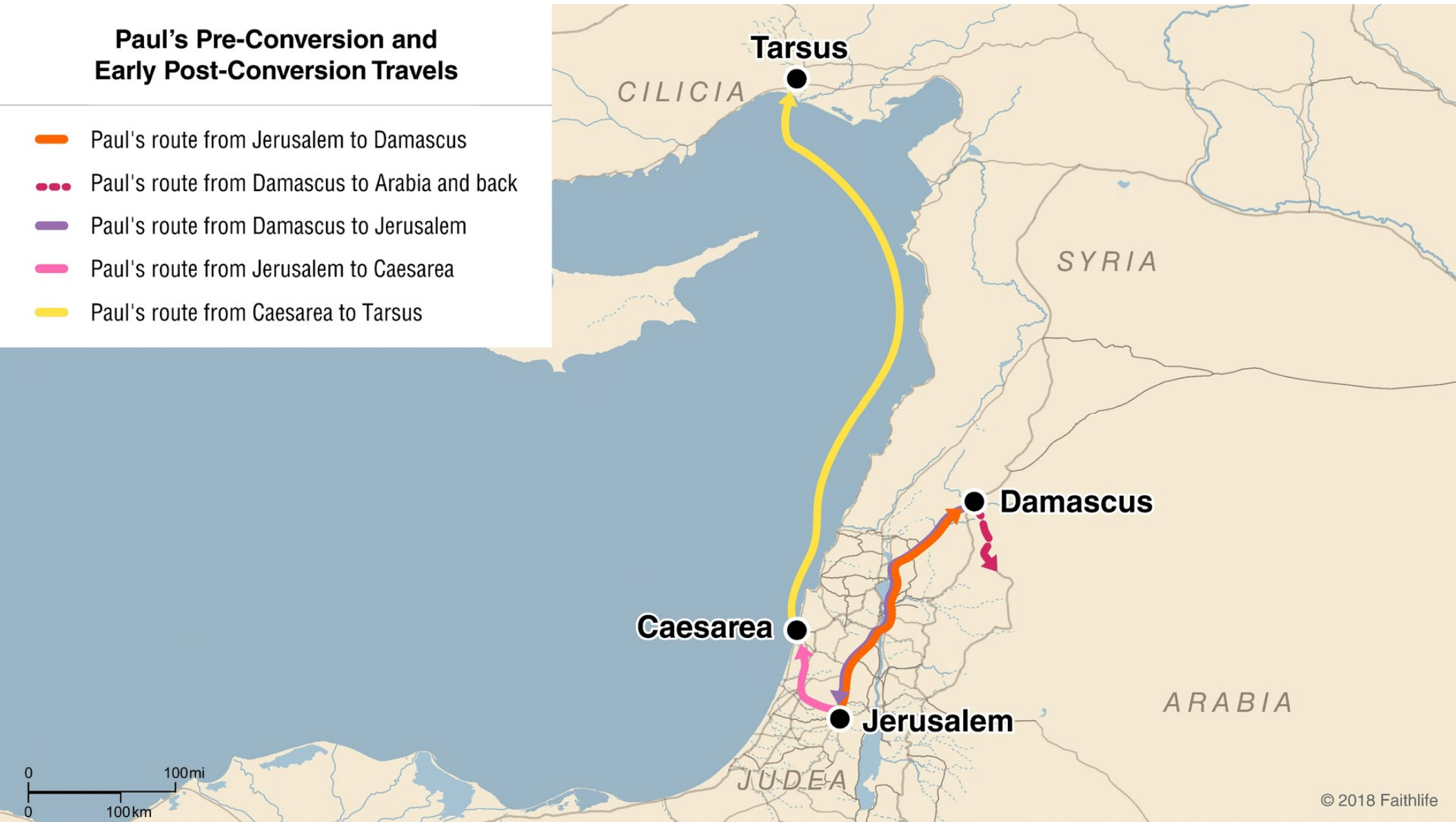

## Paul's Pre-Conversion and Early Post-Conversion Travels

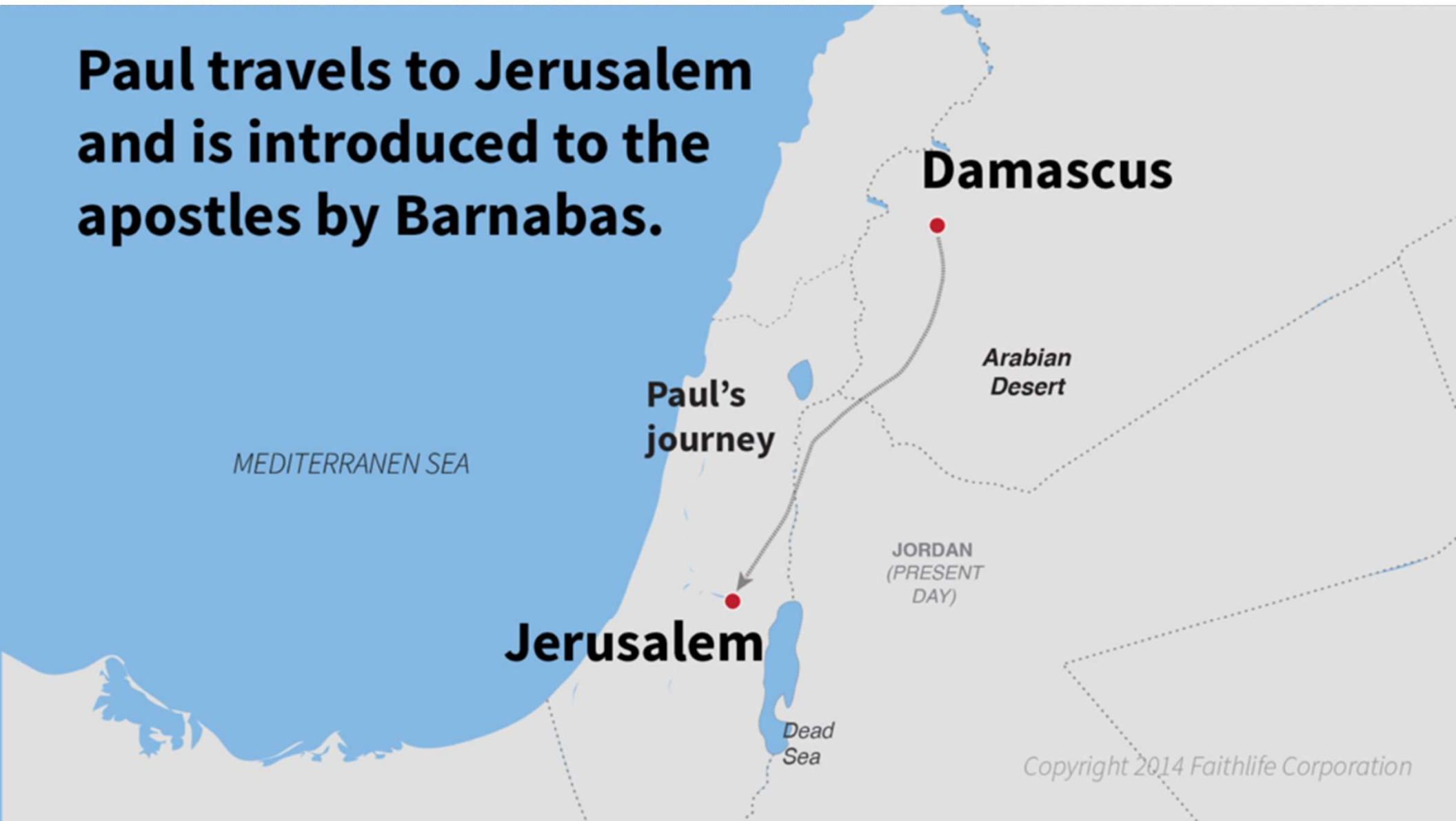
- Paul's route from Jerusalem to Damascus
