

Grace and Peace SLC! I miss you all and already miss worshiping with our Congregation. I am worshiping at different local churches and gathering ideas and reflecting. My studies on the "Great De-Churching of America" are going well and I'm struck by how this topic has resonated with you all. It is no surprise, as we are talking about many of our beloved friends and family. Did you know that 40 million people in the US who once worshiped at least monthly have stopped attending all together over the last 25 years? This means we are witnessing the greatest religious shift in the history of our country. The research is showing that people "de-church" for many reasons but there is a large percentage who simply fall away because of a move, COVID, or other practical factors. When these people are asked what it would take to have them return, they said an invitation would do it! Who do you know who you could reach out to and invite to come back to community worship? I am hoping to get you a survey to your de-churched friends and family so we can listen and get data more specific to our context. I'm so thankful for the time away to rest and study.
