Fifteen Grade 3-5 girls at Esquire Hills Elementary School committed to "Girls on the Run", a 12-week program designed to grow self-confidence while building healthy physical and mental habits. The lessons blend physical activities with life skills development, including managing emotions, resolving conflict, helping others, teamwork and making healthy choices. As a team they do a Community Impact Project and a 5K run. Through our community partnership with Esquire Hills, SLC helped financially sponsor 5 girls for this program. Now it's time to cheer them on!

The culmination of their efforts is participating in a 5K run with girls from Kitsap, Mason and Pierce counties. Along with the 15 EH girls, we also have an SLC student from Poulsbo who will be running in the race.

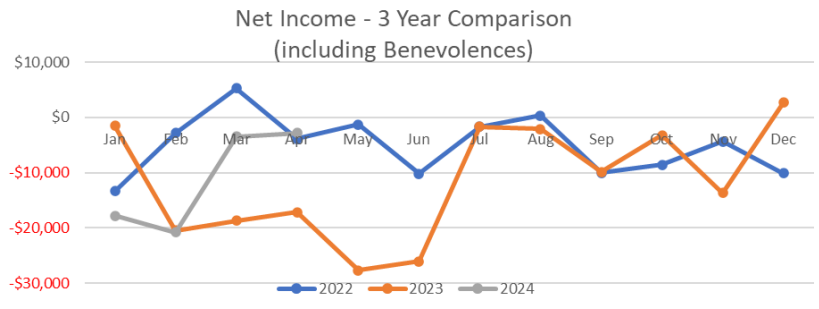
