



Pamela Roberts was recognized as a national cello talent by age 11. Awarded the top music scholarship at the University of Washington for five years and a 3 -year fellowship to the Aspen Music Festival, Pamela became faculty cellist at the University of Puget Sound. She was principal cellist of the Tacoma Symphony and 5th Avenue Theatre Orchestra in Seattle. As soloist Pamela performed with the Seattle Symphony, Bremerton WestSound Symphony, Aspen Music Festival and Port Townsend Symphony Orchestra, among others. She is principal cellist of the Port Townsend Symphony Orchestra and a founder/Artistic Director of the PTSO Chamber Music Series. Her teachers included Eva Heinitz, Toby Saks, Daniel Lynch and Alan Harris. Pamela lives in Quilcene with her husband, Howard Gilbert, a well-known jazz drummer and former member of the Seattle Symphony.


