

You could get a check in the mail if you're eligible for Washington's **new Working Families Tax Credit (WFTC)**. As many as 400,000 lower income Washington households are estimated to be eligible for a tax refund of up to \$1,255.

Last year was the program's first and 160,000 eligible Washingtonians each received an average of \$714 back. There are at least 240,000 families eligible for their check who haven't applied, according to the governor's office. Check to see if you are eligible on this website:

The federal 2024 tax-filing season officially began on Jan. 29. *The deadline to file federal taxes is Monday, April 15, but applicants have three years to file for the state's Working Families Tax Credit.*
