

GROUP QUESTIONS: Jesus Stories with Pastor Greg

1. What three things would you do if you were invisible?
2. Take a minute to summarize with your group the main point of the message from Sunday and/or briefly share what stood out to you the most.
3. Luke 19:1-10 is the story of Jesus and Zacchaeus. Pastor Greg pondered why Zacchaeus might have wanted to see Jesus so badly. He also wondered how did Jesus know Zacchaeus' name? Read the story together. What are you curious about from the story? Or what possible answers do you have to Greg's questions?
4. Pastor Greg pointed out that Jesus never said a critical word about Zacchaeus. In fact he isn't known for criticizing or correcting sinners in his time at all. How do these observations impact how you see Jesus?
5. Pastor Greg ended with a quote by Martin Luther - "Sin boldly. But trust God more boldly still." Greg suggested this quote speaks to our freedom. Discuss this idea together.
