Christ's Sacrifice and Our Sacrifice

Note that the Lord's Supper is about the sacrifice of Christ on the cross 2000 years ago. The Lord's Supper is not a sacrifice in itself.

Christ's Sacrifice



Christ is the final sacrifice. Hebrews 7:27, Hebrews 9:27-28, Hebrews 7:23-25

Our Sacrifices

The sacrifice of Christ that we remember during the Lord’s Supper does not prompt us to again offer the sacrifice of Christ but to offer the sacrifice of ourselves in gratitude to Christ. 1 Peter 2:9

There are six types of sacrifices we offer in response to the sacrifice of Christ.

1. We are to offer our bodies as “living sacrifices.” Romans 12:1-2.
2. We are to offer the “sacrifice of praise.” Hebrews 13:15 Psalm 116:17
3. Prayer is a sacrifice. Revelation 5:8, 8:3, and 8:4
4. Brokenness over our sin before God is a sacrifice. Psalm 51:17
5. Our life of service to God and others prompted by faith is a sacrifice pleasing to God. Philippians 2:17
6. Our works that result from faith are sacrifices pleasing to God. Philippians 4:18, Hebrews 13:16,
