1. Always Rejoice

1 Thessalonians 5:16

- 2 Timothy 3:12—Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted
- Psalm 16:11 You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.
- Philippians 3:7-9—But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him,

2. Always Pray

1 Thessalonians 5:17

(1) Pray together

- Acts 1:14—All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and his brothers.
- Acts 2:42-43—And they devoted themselves to the apostles ' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. And awe came upon every soul,
