Historical Context

The Church

- Pope – Christ’s vicar or representative
- Seven sacraments – baptism, confirmation, the Mass, penance, marriage, ordination, and last rites
- The Mass – repetition of Christ’s sacrifice
- Infused grace – received at baptism
- Venial sins – less serious sins
- Mortal sins – destroys the grace of justification
- Penance – restores the grace of justification
- Salvation – merited when you are righteous enough
