



Family Worship Guide: Lesson 23

Isaiah

Main Idea

In the wake of Judah's disobedience and idolatry, the Lord sends the prophet Isaiah to preach His judgment. However, the Lord is merciful in forgiving those who return to Him. He promises redemption for the Israelites, new heavens and a new earth, and a Savior who will rescue those who trust in Him.

Lesson Review

- Q What did Isaiah say when he saw the Lord's holiness?
 - A *"Woe is me! For I am lost... for I am a man of unclean lips." (Isaiah 6:5)*
- Q What did the seraph say after touching Isaiah's lips with the coal?
 - A *"Your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for." (Isaiah 6:7)*
- Q According to Isaiah 53, why was the Servant pierced and crushed?
 - A *He was pierced for our transgressions and crushed for our iniquities. (Isaiah 53:5)*
- Q What does God promise to create in Isaiah 65?
 - A *New heavens and a new earth. (Isaiah 65:17)*

Q How do these promises point us to Christ?

A *Jesus is the suffering Servant who has already borne our sins and brought forgiveness, and He is also the Lord who will one day come and make all things new.*

Catechism - 1693 Baptist Catechism

Q What is the duty which God requireth of man?

A *The duty which God requireth of man is obedience to His revealed will (Mic 6:8; 1Sa 15:22).*

Q What did God at first reveal to man for the rule of his obedience?

A *The rule which God at first revealed to man for his obedience was the moral law (Rom 2:14-15; 10:5).*

Family Devotion Questions

Q How did Isaiah respond to God's call?

A *Isaiah first confessed his sin when he saw God's holiness, and after the Lord cleansed him, he said, "Here am I! Send me."*

Q What kinds of messages did Isaiah give the people of Judah?

A *He gave both bad news and good news—warnings of judgment because of their sin, and promises of mercy, restoration, and a coming Savior.*

Q Why did Judah get some bad news from the Lord (Isaiah 6:9-13, also Isaiah 1:2-4, Isaiah 5:13-14)?

A *Because they disobeyed God, worshiped idols, and refused to trust Him, they deserved His judgment.*

Q What was the good news for Judah? What is the good news for us?

A *The good news was that God promised forgiveness, restoration, and a Savior. For us, the good news is that the savior, Jesus Christ, has come so that we can be forgiven and made new.*

Q How can someone spend eternity with God in heaven?

A *By turning from sin and trusting in Jesus Christ alone—believing that lived to make us righteous, died to bear our guilt, and rose that we might live with him forever in the new heavens and new earth.*

Prayer

Father in heaven, You are holy, holy, holy. Like Isaiah, we confess that we are sinners in need of cleansing. Thank You for sending Jesus, the suffering Servant, who was pierced for our transgressions and crushed for our iniquities. Thank You that through His wounds we are healed. Help our family to trust in Christ alone for forgiveness and to look forward to the new heavens and new earth You have promised. In Jesus' name, amen.
