Ecclesiastes 4

Introduction

- Purely "under the sun" perspective.
- The Preachers tells us what he saw then what is better.

Oppressive Ambition - 4:1-3

- The Preacher sees oppression, a thirst for power.
- There is no comfort for the oppressed.
- One "under the sun" solution to oppression is death.
- What is better is to never be born.
- The "above the sun" solution is the God of all comfort.

Envious Ambition - 4:4-6

- The Preacher sees envy and covetousness.
- One "under the sun" solution is no ambition.
- What is better is a balance between work and rest.
- The "above the sun" solution is godly contentment.

Selfish Ambition - 4:7-12

- The Preacher sees a lonely selfish man.
 - Never satisfied.
 - Inwardly focused.
- What is better is companionship.
 - Good reward.
 - Help in time of need.
 - o Support and comfort in time of distress.
 - Protection and defense in time of attack.
 - o Many companions are better than few companions.
- The "above the sun" solution is community.

Political Ambition - 4:13-16

- A ruler who has wise counselors is better but still forgotten.
- The "above the sun" solution is an all wise king whose kingdom will not pass away.
