## English Reformation

1408 – *Constitutions of Oxford*

1520 – Thomas Bilney organizes meetings at the White Horse Inn

1531 – Bilney burned at the stake

### William Tyndale

- 1494 – Tyndale born
- 1512 – earned bachelor’s degree
- 1515 – earned master’s degree
- 1521 – tutored and pastored in his home town
- 1523 – sought permission to translate the Bible into English
- 1524 – left for Germany
- 1526 – prints 6000 copies of the English New Testament
- 1528 – *The Parable of the Wicked Mammon*
- 1536 – Tyndale executed

### King Henry VIII

- Age 17 – married Catherine of Aragon
- 1534 – Act of Supremacy
- Henry marries Anne Boleyn
- Beheads Anne Boleyn and marries Jane Seymour
- 1538 – encourages the reading of the Bible
- 1543 – prohibits Bible reading

### King Edward VI

- 1547 – Edward becomes king



- *Book of Common Prayer*
- 1553 – Edward dies

## **Lady Jane Grey**

### **Bloody Mary**

- Reverted England to Catholicism
- Hugh Latimer – Bishop of Worcester
- Nicholas Ridley – Bishop of London

### **Queen Elizabeth I**

- Returns England to Protestantism
- New Act of Supremacy proclaiming Elizabeth the head of the Church of England
- 1559 – new prayer book
- 1570 – Pope excommunicates Elizabeth
- 1587 – Mary, Queen of Scots executed
- 1603 – Elizabeth dies

## **Scottish Reformation**

- 1528 – Patrick Hamilton burned for heresy
- 1542 – James V dies, James Hamilton rules as regent

### **John Knox**

- Went to Geneva during reign of Bloody Mary
- 1558 - *The First Blast of the Trumpet Against the Monstrous Regiment of Women*
- 1559 – Knox returns to Scotland
