- d. Two things
  - We are invited to join Him in this project He does not need us but He wants us
    - 1. Any parent here knows that getting help from their 3 year old on some project usually means it takes longer, it will be messier and there will be more mistakes but we want them there
      - a. It is more enjoyable
      - b. It is a learning process
      - c. It is a way to get closer and build the relationship
  - ii. We too are creators
    - 1. Not ex nihlo

      - a. We can bring a little order out of a relative chaos
