 - The man of lawlessness will use deceptive miracles and false teaching.
 - The man of lawlessness is revealed after what is restraining him is removed.
 - The man of lawlessness will be completely destroyed at the coming of Christ.

Signs Indicating Divine Judgment

2. These signs are signs of God's judgment but it does not mean that those who experience these things are special objects of God's wrath.

3. These signs are not signs of the end since Jesus said in Matthew 24:6 that when people see these things they should not be alarmed because "the end is not yet." These are the "beginning of the birth pains."
4. As with the other signs, wars, earthquakes, and famines will occur between the first and second comings of Christ.
