- 3. These signs are not signs of the end since Jesus said in Matthew 24:6 that when people see these things they should not be alarmed because "the end is not yet." These are the "beginning of the birth pains."
- 4. As with the other signs, wars, earthquakes, and famines will occur between the first and second comings of Christ.
