



## Introduction

We will look at some of the more overarching narratives that typify Christ and His passions.

## Typical Institutions

### Explicit

1. 1 Corinthians 5:7, 1 Peter 1:19. Christ is the passover lamb.
2. Ephesians 5:22-33. Christ's relationship to the church is a better marriage portrayal
3. Hebrews 9:11-14, 10:1-18. Jesus is a better sacrifice than bulls or goats.

### Implicit

1. Exodus 12:14-20, 1 Corinthians 5:8 Feast of Unleavened bread. Since we have been redeemed by the lamb, we must not have any trace of leaven of sin about us.
2. Leviticus 23:33-44, 1 Peter 2:11, Feast of Booths
3. Genesis 17:9-14, Romans 2:25-29. Circumcision was a sign of the covenant between God and His people. As regenerate believers, our hearts are circumcised as a sign of God's covenant with us.
4. Leviticus 25:8-55, Galatians 3:23-29. The Jubilee was a time when all things that were enslaved were returned back to their original states. When Christ died and resurrected, he rescued those enslaved to the law to their rightful place (man's original state is in fellowship with God)

## Typical Events

### Explicit

1. Matthew 24:38-39, Luke 17:26-27. Jesus' second coming will be like the days of Noah entering the arc.
2. Luke 17:28-30, 2 Peter 2:5-6, Jude 1:7. Jesus' second coming will bring great destruction like Lot's days in Sodom and Gomorrah
3. Galatians 4:21-31. Child of Hagar is the Child of the flesh (law) and the child of Sarah is the child of the promise (elect).
4. Hebrews 4:1-11. Jesus provides the real Sabbath rest/ better Joshua by providing rest.
5. Acts 3:25-26. Jesus is the true offspring of Abraham
6. Matthew 12:38-41, 16:4, Luke 11:29-30, 32. Jesus is the better Jonah

### Implicit

1. Genesis 37:5-36, 41:41-45, Philippians 2:5-10. Joseph was a lowly shepherd boy who dreamed that every knee should bow, in heaven and earth, to him and he was rid of by his brothers. This led to him being elevated to the highest power and was given a name above every other. Jesus is much more.
2. Genesis 22:1-14, Romans 3:24-25. Sacrifice of Isaac
3. Daniel 6:1-24, Matthew 26:57-68, Luke 23:1-4, 24:1-2. Daniel and lions den



4. Exodus 3:7-8, 12:33-40, Galatians 3:23-27, Hebrews 13:14. Exodus
5. 1 Samuel 17:24-33, 45-51, Philippians 2:7-8, 1 Corinthians 15:56, Hebrews 9:26. David and Goliath
6. Genesis 27, 2 Corinthians 5:19-21. Jacob and Esau
