* Acts 2:1-6

1. The Suddenness of the Spirit

- Acts 2:2—suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind
- John 3:8—The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes.

2. The Sound of the Spirit

- Acts 2:2—it filled the entire house where they were sitting
- 3. The Sight of the Spirit

4. The Saturation of the Spirit

- Acts 2:2—filled the entire house where they were sitting.
- Acts 2:4—And they were all **filled** with the Holy Spirit

5. The Speech of the Spirit

- Genesis 11:1—Now the whole earth had one language and the same words.
- Acts 2:9-11—Parthians and Medes and Elamites and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabians.
- Philippians 2:9-11—God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
