



Family Worship Guide: *Lesson 10*

Moses and the Exodus

Main Idea:

As part of God's great plan for the nation of Israel, He freed them from slavery in Egypt. Only those who sacrificed a lamb and painted its blood on their doorposts would be spared the death of the firstborn. This first Passover paints a picture of the atoning work of Christ to come.

Parents Read Ahead of Time:

Parents, take time to read through ***Exodus 1-14*** in advance. This long but foundational section of Scripture tells how God delivered His people from bondage through mighty acts of judgment and mercy. Reading the whole passage will help you explain how the Passover foreshadows the gospel of Christ, the true Lamb of God, whose blood saves His people from death.

Read Together Aloud:

✠ *Exodus 12:21–28*

Lesson Review:

Q. Why were the Israelites slaves in Egypt?

A. Because many years after Joseph's death, a new Pharaoh arose who did not remember Joseph or what he had done (Exodus 1:8).

Q. How did God show His power to Pharaoh?

A. Through ten plagues that revealed His supremacy over all Egyptian gods.

Q. What protected the Israelites from the final plague?

A. The blood of a spotless lamb painted on their doorposts.

Moses and the Exodus

Q. What does the Passover lamb point forward to?

A. Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God, who shed His blood to save His people from sin and death.

Catechism Connection - Baptist Catechism (1693):

Q24: Who is the Redeemer of God's elect?

A: The only Redeemer of God's elect is the Lord Jesus Christ, who, being the eternal Son of God, became man, and so was, and continues to be, God and man in two distinct natures and one person forever.

Family Devotion Questions:

Q. How does the blood of the Passover lamb help us understand what Jesus did for us on the cross?

Q. When you think about God rescuing His people from slavery in Egypt, what does that show you about His love and power toward you today?

Q. Imagine being an Israelite child in Egypt on the night of the first Passover—what would you have seen, heard, and felt as your family waited for God to pass over your home?

Father in heaven, we thank You for Your great plan of redemption. Just as You saved Israel through the blood of the lamb, You have saved us through the blood of Jesus Christ, the true and great Lamb of God. Help us to trust in His sacrifice, obey Your Word, and rejoice in Your power to save. In Jesus' name, amen
