



## Family Worship Guide: Lesson 36

### The Triumphal Entry

## Main Idea

*On Palm Sunday, Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a colt to the adoration of the crowd. This act showed that He is God's promised King and that He willingly stepped toward His own suffering and death.*

## Scripture Readings

- ✠ *John 12:12–19 – The Triumphal Entry*
- ✠ *Mark 11:1–10 – Jesus Sends for the Colt*
- ✠ *Mark 9:30–32 – Jesus Foretells His Death*
- ✠ *John 6:14–15 – The People Seek to Make Jesus King*

## Lesson Review

**Q** Why did Jesus ride into Jerusalem on a young colt? (John 12:14-15; Zechariah 9:9)

**A** *To fulfill the ancient prophecy of Zechariah, revealing Himself as the promised King—humble and coming in peace, not on a warhorse.*

**Q** What did the crowd shout as Jesus entered Jerusalem? (John 12:13)

**A** *“Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel!”*

**Q** Why was the crowd so large? (John 12:17-18)

**A** *Many had heard that Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead and came out to see Him for themselves.*

**Q** How did the religious leaders respond to Jesus' entry? (John 12:19)

**A** *They were frustrated, saying that the whole world had gone after Him, and they could do nothing to stop it.*

**Q** What did Jesus say would happen to the Son of Man? (Mark 9:31)

**A** *He would be delivered into the hands of men, killed, and after three days rise again.*

### Family Devotion Questions

**Q** Why was it important that Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a colt?

**A** *It fulfilled the prophecy in Zechariah 9:9 about the coming King, showing that Jesus is exactly who God promised to send.*

**Q:** What king-like qualities does Jesus have?

**A** *Like the Davidic kings before Him, King Jesus protects His people, (the church), defeats their enemies (sin, death, and Satan), and rules over all things with justice and mercy forever.*

**Q** What's the difference between being a fan and a follower of Jesus?

**A** *A fan admires Jesus from a distance and follows when it is easy or popular. A true follower trusts and obeys Jesus as King even when it costs something.*

**Q** How can you worship Jesus?

**A** *By trusting Him as your King, obeying His Word, praising Him with your words and your life, and telling others who He is.*
