



## Family Worship Guide: Lesson 25

Daniel

### Main Idea

*God commands His followers to worship only Him. In the past, some rulers tried to force people to worship false gods, but only the God of the Bible is the true, mighty, sovereign God. Today, God still wants us to obey His command to worship only Him.*

### Lesson Review

**Q** What did Daniel decide not to do in Babylon?

**A** *Daniel resolved that he would not defile himself with the king's food (Daniel 1:8).*

**Q** Who removes kings and sets up kings?

**A** *God removes kings and sets up kings (Daniel 2:21).*

**Q** What did Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego say about their God before they were thrown into the fire?

**A** *They said that their God was able to deliver them, but even if He did not, they would not serve the king's gods or worship the golden image (Daniel 3:17-18).*

**Q** What did Daniel do even when it was against the law?

**A** *He knelt and prayed to God three times a day (Daniel 6:10).*

**Q** How does Daniel 12:3 point us to Christ?

**A** *Daniel 12:3 promises eternal glory for the wise and righteous. We shine forever not because we are good enough, but because Jesus makes us righteous and gives us everlasting life.*

## Catechism - 1693 Baptist Catechism

**Q** What is the preface to the Ten Commandments?

**A** *The preface to the Ten Commandments is in these words: "I am the Lord thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage" (Exo 20:2).*

**Q** What doth the preface to the Ten Commandments teach us?

**A** *The preface to the Ten Commandments teacheth us that, because God is the Lord, and our God and redeemer, therefore we are bound to keep all His commandments (Luk 1:74-75; 1Pe 1:15-19)."*

## Family Devotion Questions

**Q** What are the Ten Commandments?

**A** *The Ten Commandments are God's moral law given in Exodus 20, teaching us how to love and obey Him.*

**Q** How does Daniel inspire you to worship God alone?

**A** *Daniel shows us that worshiping God is worth more than safety, comfort, or approval from others. He loved and feared God more than kings.*

**Q** **Have you ever heard of someone who was persecuted for choosing to obey God?**

**A** *Yes—many Christians throughout history have suffered for obeying Christ. Like Daniel, they trusted God rather than giving in to pressure.*

**Q** **How can you trust God when you face problems?**

**A** *We trust God by praying, remembering that He is sovereign over kings and circumstances, and believing that He works all things for His glory and our good.*

**Q** **How can you be faithful to God when others pressure you to disobey?**

**A** *By remembering that God alone is King, praying for courage, and choosing obedience even when it costs us something—just as Daniel did.*

## Prayer

*Lord God, You are the only true and sovereign King. You remove kings and set up kings. Give us courage like Daniel to worship You alone. Help us to pray faithfully, obey boldly, and trust You completely. And thank You that, by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone, we have eternal life and will shine forever in Your kingdom. Amen.*
