Introduction

What must I do to inherit eternal life?

❖ **Luke 10:25-28**

- ❖ John 5:24—*Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and **believes** him who sent me has **eternal life**. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.*
- ❖ John 3:16-18—*For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever **believes** in him should not perish but have **eternal life**. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.*
- ❖ Proverbs 26:5—*Answer a fool according to his folly, lest he be wise in his own eyes.*
- ❖ Ephesians 3:18-19—*may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge*
